- _____ **DeMotte Police Reserves** – Eligibility: Senior pursuing study of Criminal law or Law enforcement. Must include an essay answering the question “Why a Career in Law Enforcement is Important to Me.” May include an interview. **Deadline March 1**
- _____ **DeMotte Rotary** - Eligibility: Senior in top 20% of class. Top candidates will be interviewed. Must include an essay entitled “Service Above Self”. Use the General Application available either on the guidance website or in the guidance office. **Deadline April 30th**
- _____ **Education License Plate Scholarship** – Eligibility: Senior who will pursue career in education. **Deadline March 15th**
- _____ **Hamstra (Wilbert) Scholarship** - Eligibility: Senior planning to attend an accredited post-secondary training institution and entering a career in technology or building trades. **Deadline March 12 Noon at Jasper Foundation**
- _____ **Hyatt (Andrea) Memorial Scholarship** – Eligibility: Senior planning a career in respiratory therapy. Must be in top 50% of class and have GPA of 2.0 or higher. **Deadline March 12**
- _____ **Jasper County Voiture 40 ET 8 Scholarship** – Eligibility: Senior pursuing a degree in the nursing field (RN, LPN). An interview is required for finalists. **Deadline March 12**
- _____ **Kankakee Valley Community Scholarship** - Eligibility: Senior accepted to 2 or 4 year college or university. Please include a one page, double spaced essay describing how you have made an impact on your community. Feel free to use examples from church involvement, extra curricular activities, Civic organizations, etc. **Deadline March 18**
- _____ **KV Bass Basters Scholarship** – Eligibility: Senior who plans to attend a four-year college or university. Must include a 1000 word essay entitled “The Effects of a Clean Environment on Our Society.” **Deadline March 12**
